Faculty Development Program (FDP 33) for Counsellors/ Special Educators was conducted and was attended by the school counselor and special educator teachers. Various topics pertinent to Sensory Integration, Perception, Managing adolescence in CWSN, and such were handled by the resource person.

Classes VI and IX, primary classes II and V embarked on their annual picnics during the week. The venues for the picnics were chosen for recreational and educational values like Spice farms, Science center, Walk In Aquarium.



Review of Percy Jackson, The Series

Rick Riordan's Percy Jackson series got me interested in Greek mythology—the modern world's take on heroes and myths makes them easier for a young audience to understand and there are many easter eggs for those who know about their myths. The Lightning Thief starts the series wonderfully, introducing a lot of loveable characters that stay throughout the series.

Percy is a hero who's brave and loyal for the right reasons; his love for his family, both blood and found, makes him a genuine and lovable protagonist. He isn't a hero who is unwillingly dragged through his own story; instead, he becomes immersed in this world along with us, the readers, and he quickly comes to love his fantastical new life and the people that came with it. Percy is a dyslexic child who has trouble spelling out words and with their pronunciation. He would always get into trouble because of the disasters that came, which got him expelled from all the schools he was enrolled in.

The supporting cast is just as strong and substantial: Annabeth is never reduced to a damsel-in-distress, and she's admired for her intelligence and strength rather than her looks. The quests that the heroes and half-bloods must embark on throughout the series are direct parallels to ancient Greek myths, but they feel fresh and new through the eyes of the modern heroes. From the first novel, the plot is engaging and exciting, appealing to anyone who's ever felt like they didn't belong. Between all of the action, magic and riddles, it's a truly heart-warming story about finding friends who eventually become family and houses that eventually become homes.

Riodan started the series as a way to help his dyslexic son feel like he could be a hero too; the series has become more progressive and inclusive as it goes along, reaching out to kids who struggle to see themselves in stories.
