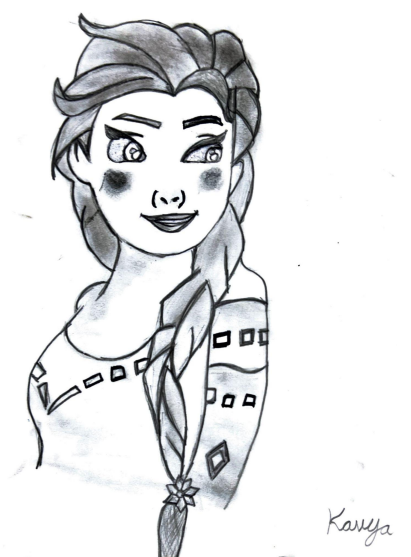

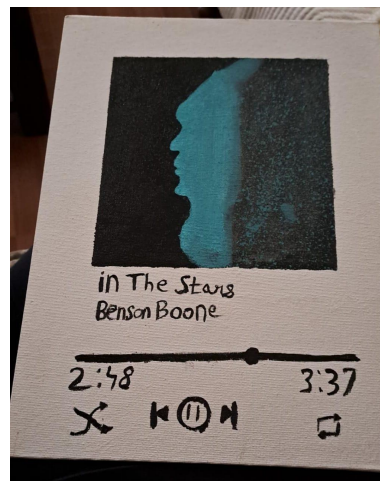

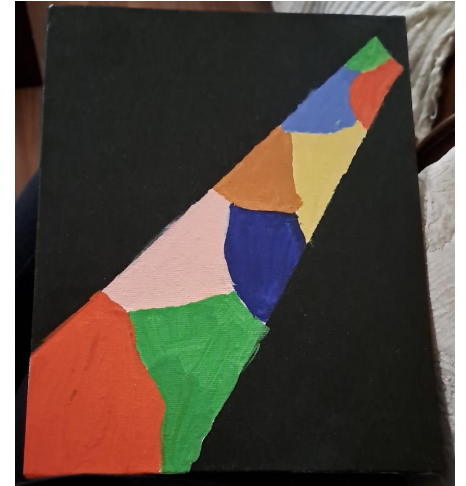

First we packed our stuff and left from our house .On the way we stopped at a restaurant for breakfast. The breakfast was very yummy! We enjoyed it.

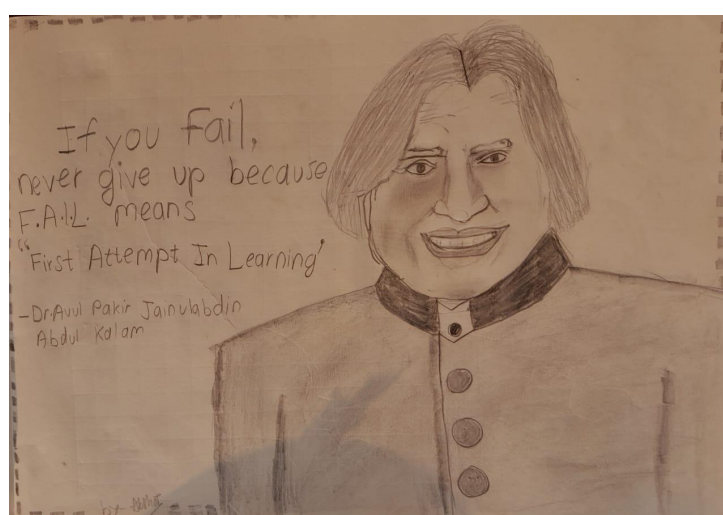

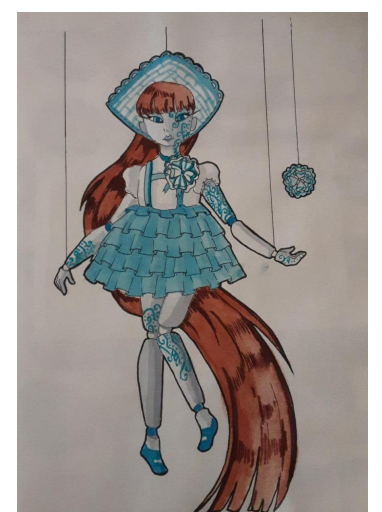

IF THE WORLD WAS BLACK AND WHITE

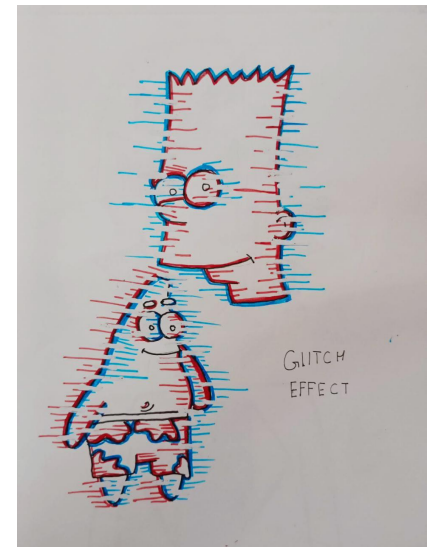
If the world was black and white

 For me so dear will never be another

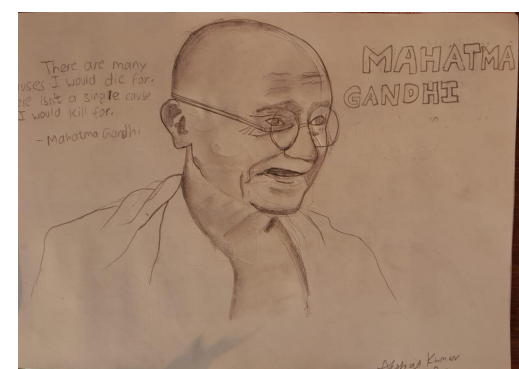
